The Family Literacy ESOL Program for non-native English speaking parents is designed to help parents learn English language skills for life, work, and to fully partner in their child's education.

To participate in this program, parents must have a child 0~16 years old and enrolled in Baltimore County Public Schools, the Judy Center of Baltimore County or Baltimore County Head Start. *No Class Cost – Grant Funded. Student book and workbook are not included.

Family Literacy ESOL classes are on-line via ZOOM. Students must have unlimited internet access, a computer or tablet with camera, or smart phone with speakers or headphones.

Due to COVID19, placement testing and registrations are following the safety guidelines from the state and county. You must wear a mask at all times during the registration process.

How to register:

- To register for any Family Literacy ESOL class, go to any of the locations listed above.
- Registrations are in person only. No phone or mail-in registration.
- **Arrive on Time.** Registration is on a first come-first served basis and will take 2 to 3 hours.
- Students must be at least 18 years of age and officially withdrawn from high school to enroll.
- To request an accommodation for a disability, please call 443-840-3428. Please allow staff adequate time to arrange it before registration.
- Students with an F-1 or J-1 visa are not eligible for these grant funded* classes.
- All students **MUST** take a test.
- For safety, space in the room is limited. You need to social distance while waiting to register.
- You **MUST wear a mask** at all times during the registration process.
- Only registering students are allowed inside the registration room. No family members or friends are allowed in the registration room.
